

## Which Zotero?

# zoterobib

-no software or account required -quickly generate bibliographies

## ZOTERO Web Library

-account required, but no software -ideal for use on public computer -not all the functionality of Zotero desktop



for iOS

-software required, account optional -most of the functionality of Zotero desktop



-software required, account optional -most powerful tool with full functionality



# Teaching Zotero in 5 minutes: Lesson Plan



# 1:1 Consultation with a thesis writer

- has Downloads folder full of unlabeled PDFs
- not (just) focused on citations
- eye on a future Masters program
- may want to troubleshoot a technical issue

# Top features for thesis writers

## Accounts & **Storage Options**

No account	
-free	
-unlimited items and files	
-items and PDFs saved	
locally	

#### Free account

-sync across devices -300 MB of free storage -option to not save PDFs to the cloud

## Paid online file

storage

-\$20-\$120/year for individuals -2GB, 6GB, and unlimited storage options

#### Institutional Storage

-unlimited storage for users -pricing based on lab or institution size
